Three Things Happened At The Same Time

Maine Free College

The state of Maine created an opportunity for all high school or HiSET graduates.

High School Graduates

The State of Maine had a large number of multilingual learners graduate from Maine high schools.

Adult Learners

The State of Maine had a large number of multilingual learners enter into adult education programs to earn their American high school diploma or high school equivalency (HiSET).

Are You Student Ready?

Understanding MLL High School Graduates

- Student has earned a high school diploma.
 - Based on credits earned in the student's home country.
 - Based on credits earned in the American high school.
- GPA may be based on an inclusive classroom (ESOL).
- GPA may place student in college-level courses.
- High school has said the student is ready for college by graduating them.
- College has said the student is ready for college by accepting them.
- Tremendous amount of value is placed on education by the student's family.

Understanding Multilingual Adult Learners

- Student has earned a high school diploma or high school equivalency.
- Tremendous amount of value is placed on higher education by the learner.
- Higher education =
 - Increased professional opportunities.
 - Increased income.
 - o Ability to financially support self and family.
- Learner's academic English will either be college-ready or very close to college-ready.



Why?

- American college system is different than international college systems.
- Multilingual learners deserve to have all the facts about their Maine Free College Scholarship including:
 - Costs associated if learner starts with remedial classes.
 - o Implications if a learner is placed too high according to multiple measures.
 - What can happen if learner runs out of time.
 - Benefits of working with adult education program and starting later (if possible).
- Multilingual learners deserve the opportunity to complete their college degree. Just like everyone else.
